

New Publication: Søren Kierkegaard's Postscript to the Philosophical Fragments – Edited by Philosopher Jens Staubrand

Stauer Publishing now presents a new, accessible edition of Søren Kierkegaard's central work Postscript to the Philosophical Crumbs. This edition is edited by philosopher and author Jens Staubrand, who has also selected the book's illustrations and written accompanying commentary.

Postscript to the Philosophical Crumbs (1846) is one of Kierkegaard's major works and contains a radical critique of Hegelian systematic thinking. At the same time, Kierkegaard unfolds his understanding of religiosity in two forms – respectively, religiosity A and B – and addresses concepts such as irony, humor, and eternal validity.

Through Jens Staubrand's editorial work, the reader receives not only a textually faithful and respectful edition of this classic work, but also guidance in the form of selected illustrations with explanatory captions. These visual elements and commentaries help open the work to both first-time readers and experienced Søren Kierkegaard readers.

Postscript to the Philosophical Crumbs is an intellectually demanding book. It is here that Søren Kierkegaard describes his decisive choice to become a writer – a decision

made while smoking a couple of cigars in Frederiksberg Gardens. And it is here that, for the first time under his own name, he acknowledges being the true author behind the pseudonymous writings such as Either/Or (1843) and Stages on Life's Way (1845).

This new edition makes it possible to (re)discover one of the main works of Danish philosophy in a form that combines depth and accessibility.
